*One of the most prized of California Chardonnays and one of the few that approach the classic white burgundy style; packed with fruit, while distinctly dry and light, at the same time full bodied. A highly allocated wine made in small oak cask and even smaller quantity.*
- 7 Merryvale, Starmont, Napa Valley, California**  
*Bright notes of pear, white peach, nectarine and melon are framed by a hint of mineral, toast and vanilla bean in this classic Napa Valley Chardonnay.*
- 5 Silverado, Napa**  
*Big, oaky and buttery. Malolactic fermentation occurs, making the juice soft and creamy with a mellow finish of vanilla and apricot. A full-bodied white that will match well with all hearty and rich sauces.*
- 37 Ste Michelle Chardonnay, Washington States** **by the glass**  
*This wine is a dry style with medium plus body. Beautiful aromas of pear, golden apple and pineapple. With a hint of honey with subtle spice and oak nuances.*
- 39 Far Niente, Napa Valley, California**  
*Bright melon citrus blossom & honeysuckle aromatics followed by notes of lightly toasted hazelnuts and an amazing minerality. Rounded & silky on the palate, flavors of ripe melon & citrus oil are underscored by juicy fruit and mouthwatering acidity.*
- 41 Mer Soleil, Riserva, Chardonnay, Santa Lucia Highlands, California**  
*Golden & sun kissed, the 2014 vintage opens with the fresh, tropical scents of pineapple & citrus blossom balanced by the smooth character of vanilla*
- 43 Rombauer Chardonnay, Classic California**  
*Rich, creamy texture with layers of tropical fruit, peach, melon, vanilla and soft spice*

The palate is nicely balanced, light and soft.*

*Pale straw gold in color, fresh and dry and flavorful with a firm structure leading into a lingering finish,  
it displays character and finesse.*
- 23 **Luna Nuda, Alto Adige DOC** **by the glass**  
*Soft lemon and lime flavors with a little golden delicious apple for good measure.*

### Sauvignon Blanc

- 11 **Sauvignon Blanc, Oyster Bay, Marlborough** **by the glass**  
*A stunning example of the region considered among the best for Sauvignon Blanc.  
Pungent with gunflint and honeysuckle on the nose, a tight and crisp bite with a lingering fruit finish.*
- 21 **Sauvignon Blanc, Kim Crawford, Marlborough**  
*A bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits backed by Marlborough's characteristic herbaceous notes.*
- 35 **Sterling Vineyards, Napa Valley** **by the glass**  
*The pleasant appeal begins on the nose with fragrant aromas of white peach and bright floral notes.  
Stone fruit and honeydew melon continue on the palate, accented by ripe ruby grapefruit. A vibrant  
streak of citrus continues into a long and satisfying finish.*

**49 Meiomi Rose, California**

*Delightfully dry with vibrant acidity, the wine opens to delicate aromas of strawberry, rose petal and citrus. The palate offers a mouthwatering flavors of juicy strawberry, watermelon, hay and grapefruit rind with a cool minerality on the finish.*

**47 Fleurs de Prairie, Provence, France**

*This wine is crafted in the traditional Provence style it is a pale salmon color with delicate flavors of red fruit, black current and lemon. It is a bright, refreshing acidity makes it the perfect companion to a meal such as fresh fish, summer fruits and fresh vegetables.*

82	<b>Chianti Classico Riserva, Castello di Nipozzano, Marchers de Frescobaldi DOCG</b> <i>Opening to dark fruit, plum and black currant, enriched by a pungent spiciness that betrays cinnamon and clove. The result is a solidly built but not heavy wine with a long lingering finish.</i>	
54	<b>Chianti Classico, Riserva, Nozzole DOCG</b> <i>The top Chianti of one of Tuscany's most legendary houses, crafted with masterful detail. As a Riserva, it spends half its aging life in oak barrels made in Tuscany itself.</i>	
58	<b>Chianti Classico, Riserva, Ruffino Ducale Gold Label DOCG</b> <i>This Riserva marries French and Italian wine mastery. After crushing, the wine spends its aging life in small barrels of French oak. The result is a Chianti of amazing color with a body that rivals any Bordeaux.</i>	
68	<b>Chianti Classico, Riserva, Castello di Monsanto DOCG</b> <i>Reveals a profile of red berries, herbs, crushed flowers and spices. The wine possesses an attractive up-front personality and finessed tannins; plum on the nose with a leather note. Medium bodied, with a lingering spicy cedar note on the finish.</i>	



## Cabernet Sauvignon

84	<b>Rodney Strong, Alexander Valley</b> <i>A powerful Cabernet from the hillsides of Alexander Valley, this wine is lush with blackberries, dark plum, and chocolate. The notes of dried herbs, black pepper and minerality reflects the terrior of the Alexander Valley. The soft, supple and mature tannins give this wine a strong backbone, while the 18 months of barrel aging have softened the wine enough to enjoy now.</i>	
4	<b>Justin, Paso Robles, California</b> <i>Justin's flagship wine and a workhorse of a Cabernet. Lots of oak, seventeen months of it in fact. Lot's of fruit, with a counterbalance of sumptuous plum, raspberry and black currant.</i>	
24	<b>Merryvale, Starmont, Napa</b> <i>Multiple layers of fruit open to smooth but firm tannins. Just a wisp of Merlot adds a delicate level of dryness, amplifying the blackberry and black cherry undertones.</i>	
30	<b>Silverado, Napa</b> <i>From Napa's Stag's Leap District. Few other California wineries produce a Cab that so closely resembles a left-bank Bordeaux. Look for a nose of cedar. The palate is delicately piqued by currant. And, finally, like a Margaux, a magnificent body and a dried fruit finish. This is everything a wine should be.</i>	
26	<b>Hahn Estates, Central Coast</b> <i>A pleasing aromatic mix of red berries and cassis, intermingled with lavender, allspice, &amp; brambleberry. Expressive flavors of dried cranberry, cocoa and spice are balanced by excellent texture and supple, silky tannins.</i>	
70	<b>Uppercut, California</b>	<b>by the glass</b>
	<i>Broad shouldered and muscular, yet so food friendly and approachable. The wines generous black cherry and blackberry aromas and flavors draw you in. With each sip and swirl it reveals complex hints of mocha, anise, tamari and mineral plus a racy hint of smokiness. Pairs fantastic with boldly flavored foods.</i>	
78	<b>Sterling Vintner's Collection, Central Coast</b>	<b>by the glass</b>
	<i>This wine's dark profile shows blackberry, cassis and ripe cherry, accented by notes of vanilla and cocoa. The palate is full bodied, with inviting plumpness and smooth tannins that pick up bright cherry notes and a touch of spice on the finish.</i>

102	<b>Stags Leap Artemis, Napa Valley, California</b> <i>Generous dark cherry juicy plum, currant &amp; cassis while accents of black pepper &amp; chocolate give it a classic feel.</i>	
94	<b>Caymus, Napa Valley California</b> <i>This wine opens with the vibrant scent of dark cherry, blackberry, subtly layered with warm notes of vanilla. The palate is explosive, bright, balanced, cassis at the center with flourishes of cocoa and sweet tobacco.</i>	
98	<b>Jordan, Alexander Valley</b> <i>Delicate aromas of fresh cranberry and red cherry mingle with enticing notes of cassis, chocolate &amp; tobacco. The wine is round, soft and refined with elegant flavors of red currant, fresh cut herbs, vanilla bean and allspice.</i>	
80	<b>Far Niente, Napa</b> <i>This wine offers intense aromas of ripe blackberry and boysenberry layered with baking spices and licorice. Dark mocha flavors emerge on the long finish.</i>	
88	<b>Silver Oak, Alexander Valley, California</b> <i>This cab is garnet in color with a ruby red rim. It has an alluring nose of blackberry bramble, baking spices &amp; black olive. Aromas of vanilla, cassis &amp; sage fill the glass revealing the influence of American oak barrel aging.</i>

*Here, Kendall Jackson combines grapes from Sonoma, Mendocino and Napa to create a lush, opulent Merlot. Versatile, and appropriate for any dish.*
- 76 **Sterling Vineyards, Napa** **by the glass**  
*Expressive of its origins, this Napa Merlot emanates the distinction and sophistication of this work renowned growing region. The aromas of black cherry and rich pomegranate juice are embraced by anise, allspice and cola. Wonderful hints of cranberry, red current and mocha.*

- 72 **Ferrari-Carano, Siena**  
*SIENA has delicious aromas of blackberry, raspberry jam, cocoa, toasty vanilla, licorice, and nutmeg spice that leads to flavors of Bing cherry, blueberry, sweet plums, pomegranate, mocha, sweet oak notes and a hint of butterscotch, SIENA has supple tannis and a balanced mouthfeel with lively elegance and depth.*
- 40 **Decoy, Duckhorn, Napa Valley**  
*This wine is full bodied, moderately rich and very well balanced, with complex aromas of black currant, vanilla and red licorice with a medium long finish.*

*Aromas that are long and rich in ripe cherry and berry flavors. Flavorful and silky in the mouth with good body, this wine is seductive showing wild cherries and a hint of sandalwood to complete its complex finish*

**48 Meiom, Monterey, Sonoma, Santa Barbara**

**by the glass**

*A dynamic blend of coastal California vineyards, aged in French oak barrels, evolves into an elegant balance of spice and fruit this wine is everything a pinot noir should be; rich, spicy and succulent.*

**42 " J ", Russian River, Sonoma**

*Is the proprietary name of Jordan's Pinot Noir. Russian River Valley, Sonoma's rising star, maintains a climate similar to that of Burgundy and allows this most fickle of grapes to emulate the legendary wines from that region.*

**02 Dante Pinot Noir, California**

**by the glass**

*Has a brightly perfumed nose with aromas of fresh strawberries, red plum, and candied cherry, with a light cinnamon spiciness. In the mouth, the wine is soft and pliable, with flavors of rich milk chocolate, strawberry cobbler, and fresh vanilla bean. The finish is delicate and reminiscent of toasted marshmallows.*

**46 Bella Gloss, California**

*Fruity and rich-tasting, this is filled with concentrated dark plum, boysenberry and cherry compote flavors that are liberally spiced. Peppery hints emerge as well, leading to a finish that lingers with toasty notes.*

**96 Elouan Pinot Noir, Orgeon**

*This wine is a beautiful scarlet color, with aromas of dried cherries and blackberry, high fruit notes with hints of vanilla and clove spice. The flavors are structured and balanced with bright red raspberry and cherry, boysenberry jam fill the palate, complemented by subtle notes of white pepper.*

*Strawberries, raspberries and blackberries abound offsetting the inherent peppery spice of the Shiraz. (Pen)fold in thirty percent Cabernet Sauvignon for a rich, deep, concentrated red.*

### Interesting Reds

- 12 Gerard Bertrand, Cotes Du Roussillon**  
*Intense fruity aromas of black currant and raspberry, complemented by notes of white pepper. juicy powerful and fruity on the palate with roasted notes. Silky and delicate tannis.*
- 62 Rocca della Macie, Sasyr, Maremma**  
*As it's name suggests, it's a wonderful blend of 60% Sangiovese and 40% Syrah grapes from one of Tuscany's leading wine estates.*
- 10 Montepulciano d' Abruzzo, Cantina Zaccagnini DOC** **by the glass**  
*Intense ruby color. Aromas of plums and ripe blackberry, subtle hints of spice with a touch of vanilla.*

20	<b>Barbera D'Asti, Michele Chiarlo</b> <i>This is a perfect wine for pastas and meats in tomato-based sauces. Prolonged aging in casks, rather than barrels, so oak influence is minimal.</i>	
34	<b>Barolo, Damilano, DOCG</b> <i>Perfumed with blackberry, cedar and ripe strawberries on the nose. Full-bodied, with silky tannins and a long, long finish. A balanced and well crafted red.</i>	
52	<b>Nero d'Avola, Feudo di Butera IGT</b> <i>A sturdy, full-bodied, massive representation of The Black Devil, the Island's native grape.</i>	
60	<b>Sangiovese, Poggio alla Badiola, Fonterutoli IGT</b> <i>Tuscany's noble grape stands prominent here, with a wisp of Merlot and Cabernet. The full character comes through with raspberry and bittersweet overtones.</i>	<b>by the glass</b>
100	<b>Sangiovese, Banfi Brunello Di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy</b> <i>Intense ruby red in color with garnet reflections. Aromas of violets and vanilla, with hints of licorice. Velvety palate, with tart-cherry flavors and traces of spice. Well-structured with supple tannins, superb concentration, and good acidity. Persistent finish.</i>	
14	<b>Amarone della Valpolicella, Classico, Luigi Righetti, Valgatara, Verona DOC</b> <i>A single vineyard Amarone from the Classico district of the region. Nicely dry and light, while maintaining the powerful body brought by the raisinification method.</i>	
22	<b>Ripassa di Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato, Veneto DOC</b> <i>A step above Valpolicella, on the way to Amarone. Here, the free run juice of the three grape cepage is "re-passed" over its own pomace. Thus, it picks up tannin and body, while never losing its inherent smoothness. Fermented in stainless steel and aged in oak barrels, this Ripassa gains a royal purple color, and possesses a long, lingering finish.</i>	
56	<b>Malbec, Catena, Mendoza, Argentina</b> <i>Rich fruit and ripe tannins blend together beautifully to demonstrate why the Mendoza region is synonymous with the best that Malbec has to offer.</i>	<b>by the glass</b>
6	<b>Lagone, Aia Vecchia, Toscano, Italy</b> <i>Delicate aromas of Mediterranean wood and vanilla emphasize the structured and elegant taste with intense notes of wind berries, ripe juicy sour cherries and hints of sweet spices that leave the palate satisfied and pleasantly sweet and dry. A beautiful "baby" super Tuscan</i>	<b>by the glass</b>

*This wine is produced using the RIPASSO technique. The wine is obtained by going over again, once only, the Premium Valpolicella Classico over a small quantity of Amarone marc. As a result, an authentic local wine is produced which elegantly exhibits a delightfully complex fruity aroma and spicy tones complemented with a good acidity and just the right alcohol content*
- 32 Reversanti Barolo, Piedmont, Italy**  
*100% Nebbiolo. Ruby red in color, the wine's aroma is a harmony of roses, licorice and berry fruit with subtle notes of vanilla and tobacco. It has structured layered flavors, a round velvet textured palate and a lingering finish.*
- 38 Tignanello, Marchesi Piero Antinori, IGT**  
*The one and only. A wonderful combination of Sangiovese and a little Cabernet. Perfection.*
- 36 "Baby Amarone", Masi Campofiorin, Rosso del Veronese IGT**  
*A deep ruby red color with violet tinges on the edge; intense bouquet with hints of ripe berry fruit. Ample on the palate full bodied and velvety. Attractive after taste with a hint of walnut. Perfect with many different kinds of foods, such as pasta with rich sauces.*
- 8 The Federalist, Lodi, California**  
*One of the great Zin houses of California, growing dozens of versions in various parcels throughout the state. Their old-vine, Lodi bottling is vibrant with cranberry & leather, versatile for any dish.*
- 92 Baby Blue, Blue Rock, Alexander Valley, California**  
*A blend of cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, syrah, merlot and Malbec. It is 100% estate fruit and it is a fantastic value. Blueberry, violets, chocolate and earth. Oh and you might be interested to know that blue rock is located right next door to Sliver Oak Winery.*
